The History of Australian Children's Books Display is a visual history of Australian Children's Books from the 19th to the 21st century, compiled by Alan Jager and Jane Watson-Brown. The flexibility of the design allows the display to be used in a modular way to fit any available space. Part of the CBCA Vic Branch's outreach program, the Historical Display is fully contained in its own protective satchel and comes with a range of options on how to mount the display. User notes are also included for this innovative project which also traces the history of the CBA Awards. The Historical Display can be adapted for use across many applications and areas of study. It is accessible to a wide range of students, from lower primary to senior secondary to adults. This Kit was developed as a school and community resource and contains items which the Children's Book Council of Australia (Victorian Branch) would like to share with you.



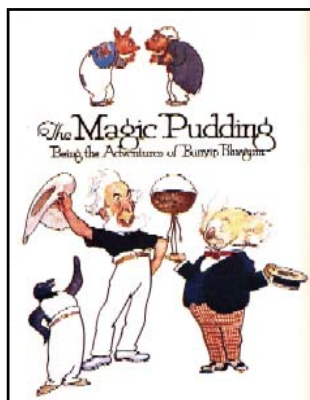
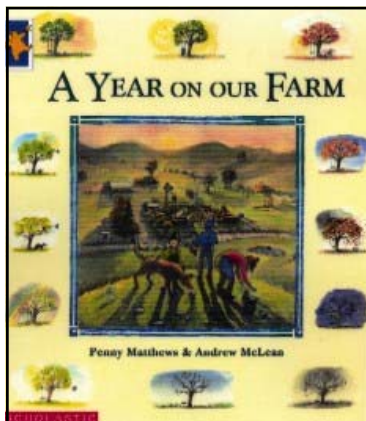
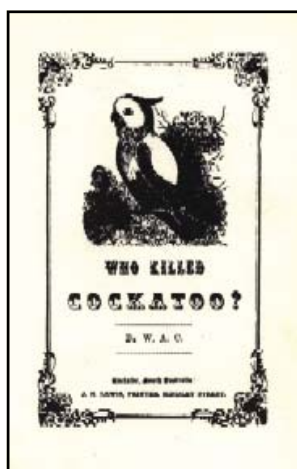
